








Experience of specific crimes: burglary, vehicle-related, vandalism & violent crime



Peace: Domestic abuse by Belfast City policing team


Percentage share of reported incidents & recorded crimes



Rate of incidents, & recorded crimes







Percentage share of reported incidents & recorded crimes










Peace: hate crime – homophobia by Belfast City local policing team








Peace: hate crime – homophobia by LGD








Peace: hate crime – sectarianism by Belfast City local policing team










High levels of worry about crime, & personal safety




Effect of fear of crime on quality of life




Peace: perception of high levels of antisocial behaviour




Peace: Crime and deprivation – percentage of SOAs by quintile of deprivation for the Crime Domain in Belfast assembly areas



Peace: Crime and deprivation – specific crimes by Belfast assembly area






Confidence in policing in Northern Ireland

Overall rating for confidence in police & police accountability arrangements




Confidence in local police




Child Protection by HSCT






Peace: Interface barriers






Participation: Life satisfaction, and Loneliness




Life satisfaction (average rating)

Loneliness – feeling 'more often lonely'



By HSCT: carers aged 16 years and over




By LGD: carers aged 0-19 years




Caring responsibility: Carer's Allowance

Number of claimants and of recipients of Carer's Allowance by assembly area




Percentage of eligible population claiming Carer's Allowance by LGD




Caring responsibility: Young carers, 0-19 years

By age-band in Belfast's assembly areas





By sex in Belfast's assembly areas




Caring responsibility: Young carers, 0-19 years

By intensity of caring in Belfast's assembly areas




Percentage of young carers by LGD

Belfast LGD


- Among LGDs, 3rd lowest percentage of people who had volunteered in the previous 12 months

Volunteering: historical data


Belfast HSCT

- Largest percentage decrease among 4 HSCTs for which there was a decrease
- Greater percentage decrease than Northern Ireland




Participation: in Sport by LGD

Membership of a sports club


